I. START OF MEETING/ ROLL CALL

Chair Mark Potts started the meeting at 9:00 am. Staff noted the attendance of the meeting.

II. Approval of the January 11, 2023 minutes

III. <u>Build With Us</u> - Butch Eley, Deputy Governor and Commissioner of Transportation for Tennessee gave a presentation concerning the Build With Us plan for TDOT. No action was needed.

IV. Discussion of the FFY2024-2025 UPWP

Staff created a draft document of the FFy2024-2025 UPWP. Still waiting on information from TDOT, such as the amount of funding. Current information is based on FFY2023 numbers. No action is needed at this time.

V. Discussion of the Transit Center Feasibility Study

Advertised for over 30 days, 3 RFQs were submitted. The consultants that submitted are: JMT, WSP, and Wendel. The Selection Committee selected WSP Associates unanimously. The TAC recommended WSP as the consultant for the study at their February 2, 2022 meeting. Staff recommended WSP Associates for the study. A motion was made by Bill Brittain, seconded by Michelle Christian, to approve WSP Consultants as submitted . The motion was approved unanimously.

VI. Information/ Updates from FHWA/ FTA/ TDOT

Sean Santalla, FHWA, had introduced Gilberto DeLeon and Zachary Coleman (new FHWA contacts in Nashville). He talked about the US Census information, as well as the FY2023 RAISE grant is out.

VII. Other Business

Staff gave some background information on the 2020 US Census. Morristown will retain its urbanized area designation. Staff stated that the LAMTPO UA boundary has taken in most of White Pine, as well as gone north of Cherokee lake and taken in Bean Station (Grainger County) as well as portions of Mooresburg (Hawkins County). Staff will be working on the donut holes and establishing the MPA boundary. No action is needed at this time.
