**I. START OF MEETING/ ROLL CALL**

**II. Approval of the February 3, 2022 minutes.**

**III. Discussion of the RAISE Grant Resolution**

The Rebuilding American Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity (RAISE) is a federal grant, 80% federal funds, 20% local match. Applications are due April 14, 2022, and submitted through grants.gov. This resolution is to support any of the local agencies wishing to pursue this grant. Staff recommends approval as submitted. A motion was made by John Johnson, seconded by Don Brown, to approve the resolution as submitted. The motion was approved unanimously.

**IV. Discussion of the FFY2022-2023 UPWP modification**
